COUNTDOWN TO PUCK DROP

1K	Catalino Family Head Hockey Coach Jeff Jackson coached his 1,000th career game as a head coach of a Division I program Friday night at home against Minnesota (Feb. 16). The team rolled to a convincing 6-1 victory over the Golden Gophers to celebrate the historic career of their leader, which spans 25 seasons over two programs; Lake Superior State University and the University of Notre Dame.
589	Catalino Family Head Hockey Coach Jeff Jackson has 589 career wins, which leads active NCAA Division I head coaches, spanning six seasons at Lake Superior State and now 19 seasons at Notre Dame. Jackson's win total ranks 10th all-time for most wins at the NCAA Division I level.
400	In game one against Michigan, Coach Jackson recorded his 400th career victory behind the Irish bench. The 6-1 win over the rival Wolverines marked the momentous occasion. Jackson now holds a 407-264-73 record with the Irish and is the winningest coach in program history.
173	Trevor Janicke set the program record for games played in game one at Ohio State earlier this season (165). The graduate forward now boasts 173 career games for the Irish and 85 points (44-41-85).
18	Catalino Family Head Hockey Coach Jeff Jackson has guided his teams at Lake Superior State and Notre Dame to 18 NCAA Tournament appearances, including winning NCAA Championships with the Lakers in 1992 and 1994, while guiding the Irish to their only four Frozen Four appearances in program history: 2008, 2011, 2017 and 2018.
17	Seventeen sets of brothers have now suited up for the Irish, including current players, Trevor and Justin Janicke , Landon and Carter Slaggert (brother Graham played 2018-22), Henry and Danny Nelson , and Brady Bjork (brother Anders played 2014-17).
12	Veteran leadership: Notre Dame's roster features 12 seniors and graduate students in 2023-24. Current graduates Ryan Bischel and Trevor Janicke have spent all five years of their collegiate careers with the Fighting Irish.
9	The Irish have nine draft picks on their roster in 2023-24 and have had at least one individual selected in each of the past 21 NHL Entry Level Drafts.
8	With the most recent being the 2019 Big Ten tournament title, Notre Dame has won eight conference championships in program history - each under Jeff Jackson (three regular-season).
4	The Irish announced four seniors and graduate students will serve as team captains this season. Landon Slaggert will wear the lone "C" while Ryan Bischel, Jake Boltmann and Trevor Janicke will serve as alternates.
2	After being named captain for the 2023-24 season, Landon Slaggert became the second Slaggert captain in program history, following his older brother Graham serving in the role in 2021-22.

QUICK HITS

- The Irish head into the Big Ten Playoff Quarterfinals after closing out the regular season at Michigan, February 23-24.
- Danny Nelson scored his ninth goal of the season in the weekend series at Yost and leads all Irish rookies in goals, assists (14) and points (23).
- After clinching a point in overtime in their final home game of the season, the Irish won the season series with the Gophers, earning seven of a possible 12 points for the conference standings.
- A night before the team honored its seniors, the rookie class led the Irish to victory over Minnesota, notching four of Notre Dame's six goals and combining for 10 points on the night.
- The freshmen had a hand in all six of the team's goals in the game one win, including two all-rookie tallies. The series' opening goal came from the all-freshmen second line of Carter Slaggert, Danny Nelson and Brennan Ali while D Nelson and C Slaggert later connected again on a goal late in the second period to take the 5-1 lead in the final minute of the second stanza.
- Cole Knuble's two goals led the team in the Friday night win. The freshman center tallied his sixth multi-point game with his two-goal performance and now boasts 15 points in his last 16 games played.
- With goals from both Slaggert brothers Friday against Minnesota, the freshman/senior duo recorded their second time both recording a goal in the same outing (prev. January 6 vs. Wisconsin). Carter Slaggert now boasts three career goals and two against Minnesota.
- The Irish travel to Ann Arbor, Michigan to conclude the regular season February 23-24. The two teams met earlier this season with a series split.
- Catalino Family Head Hockey Coach Jeff Jackson hit a career milestone with his 400th win behind the Irish bench in game one of the team's home series against Michigan. The team celebrated Friday night following their 6-1 victory over the Wolverines with a tribute video from current and former players congratulating Jackson on the accomplishment.
- Two Irish skaters recorded their first goals with the program against Ohio State earlier this season with Patrick Moynihan and Cole Knuble each finding the back of the net in game two of that series for their first goals in an Irish sweater.
- Maddox Fleming net his first career goal against the Nittany Lions, scoring the equalizer late in the third period night one to force overtime and the eventual shootout.
- The Irish closed out their first month of contests with a weekend sweep over Mercyhurst, Oct. 26-27.
- Two Irish rookies recorded first career goals when Paul Fischer and Brennan Ali helped lift the Irish to their 5-0 victory Friday night against the Lakers.

- Davis' goal came off his first shot on goal in his NCAA debut. The goal in the second period proved to be the eventual game-winner.
- With his first win of the season, Ryan Bischel picked up his eighth career shutout behind the 3-0 victory. He stopped all 22 shots faced in the contest to improve his season save percentage to .957 through two games played.

NOTRE DAME VS. MICHIGAN

- In 165 all-time meetings between the two programs the Irish trail the series 72-87-6.
- Most recently, the team fell for the first time in a regular season game at Yost Ice Arena since 2018 as the Wolverines took the series with 4-0 and 2-1 wins.
- Prior to that the Irish were 8-0-1 in their last nine regular season meetings in Ann Arbor, with the lone tie ending in a shootout win for the visiting Notre Dame squad (2023).
- Since the 2019-20 season, 11 games have been decided by a single goal with the Irish boasting an 8-3 record in those games.
- Earlier this season, the Irish and Wolverines split a weekend series in December to close out the first half home slate. Notre Dame jumped out in front early in game one of the series earlier this season with a 6-1 victory to mark Coach Jackson's 400th win behind the Irish bench.

TEAM LEADERS

- The team's leader in goals, Landon Slaggert, boasts 18 on the season and has registered 28 points in 34 games played this season. The senior captain lit the lamp twice in game two against Ohio State for his sixth career multi-goal game and fourth of the season. Most recently, he scored the fourth goal of the game against visiting Minnesota en route to a 6-1 victory over the Gophers to kick off the final home series of the regular season.
- With 15 assists this season, Ryan Siedem leads the team and while the blueliner has added three goals for 18 total points as a graduate student.
- With his shorthanded tally with 0.6 seconds left in the opening period of game one at home against Penn State, Trevor Janicke scored the team's second of the season while a man-down, joining Hunter Strand.
- After scoring the eventual game-winning goal Friday night against the Gophers, Cole Knuble joined Drew Bavaro with a team-best three GWGs on the season.
- Slaggert's five powerplay goals leads the team.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION

- Following his performance against Mercyhurst, which included a nation's best four goals on the weekend, Landon Slaggert was named the Big Ten's Third Star of the Week October 31.
- Two Irish were recognized for their play in the weekend sweep of Ohio State to open conference play at home. Bischel picked up First Star of the Week honors with a .984 save percentage in two games played. The graduate netminder stopped 60 of 61 shots faced and earned his 10th career shutout. With his third blanking of the season, Bischel leads the nation in blankings.
- Landon Slaggert also picked up conference honors following the weekend against OSU, being tabbed Third Star of the Week by the Big Ten behind a goal and three assists.
- After a weekend split against then-No. 13/12, Ryan Bischel was named Big Ten Third Star of the Week for his .953 save percentage and 1.50 goals against average.
- Following a four goal weekend which included the team's first hat trick performance in nearly two years, freshman Cole Knuble was named Big Ten Second Star of the Week. The honor came as Knuble's first of his career and it was the fifth weekly award for the Irish this season.
- After stopping 67 of 71 shots faced against one of the hottest offenses in collegiate hockey down the stretch, and holding the Gophers to just a 1.98 goals per game

- On Wednesday, January 17, Bischel was named a nominee for the Hockey Humanitarian Award as announced by the award's foundation. A graduate student seeking a degree in non-profit administration, Bischel serves as alternate captain for the team this season and is heavily involved in the local community.
- Landon Slaggert and Ryan Bischel were named nominees for the Hobey Baker Memorial Award, presented annually to the top Division I men's ice hockey player.
- As the team's leading rookie scorer, and second highest scorer on the Irish, Danny Nelson was named a nominee for the Tim Taylor Award for best rookie.
- For the second consecutive year, Ryan Bischel was named a semifinalist for the Mike Richter Award, presented annually to nation's top collegiate goaltender.

- So far this season, 10 Irish alumni have laced up their skates on the national stage.
- Seven Irish alums were highlighted on NHL opening night rosters for 2023-24, including Jake Evans (MTL), Andrew Peeke (CBJ), Ian Cole (VAN), Bryan Rust (PIT), Dennis Gilbert (CGY), Anders Lee (NYI) and Kyle Palmieri (NYI).
- Bryan Rust scored the first Penguins' goal of the 2023-24 season at the 7:04 mark of the first period.
- Jake Evans net the Canadiens' first goal of the season just 3:01 in Montreal's season.
- Vinnie Hinostroza (PIT) and Cal Petersen (PHI) made their season debuts for their respective clubs on Nov. 4.
- In his first game of the season, Hinostroza scored a goal and an assist in the Penguins' 10-2 win over San Jose.
- Spencer Stastney was called up to the Nashville Predators on Nov. 14 and made his season debut with the NHL club on Nov. 18, becoming the 10th Irish alum to appear in a game this season.
- Twenty-eight alums laced up their skates at development camps.
- The Irish were represented at just over half of all NHL clubs as alumni competed at 18 different camps with hopes of making the opening night rosters.
- New additions to NHL development camps this September include three recent Irish

- The Minnesota Wild and New York Islanders both had the most Irish alumni present as six alumni competed at the two camps, with three at each.

CAREER YEARS

- Seven Irish individuals have recorded their strongest offensive production this season with numerous career bests set.
- Ryan Siedem, who posts one of the best dump-in recovery numbers in the game has tied his career goal total this season with three. He also leads the Irish in assists with 14 apples thus far in 2023-24.
- After posting just one assist a season ago, sophomore Michael Mastrodomenico owns seven points this season, including the first collegiate goal for the blueliner.
- With 12 assists and 16 points this season, Justin Janicke is averaging .500 points/game. The 16 points and 12 assists both sit as career bests for the junior winger.
- Hunter Strand's breakout season includes the most points (18) and assists (14) of his collegiate career. His 14 assists is tied with Siedem and Danny Nelson as a team best.
- The 28 points by captain Landon Slaggert is the most of his four year career at Notre Dame while his 18 goals scored not only leads the team but is his career best in a single season. His 18 total goals ranks just outside the top-10 collegiately.
- With the lone assist Saturday on Jayden Davis' second period goal, fourth-year forward Brady Bjork tallied his first collegiate point; a memorable moment for the senior on his senior night.
- Tyler Carpenter entered this season with four career goals. The junior has since more than doubled that total, recording five goals on the season thus far and adding four assists for a career-best nine points in 2023-24.

FAMILY TIES

- The 2023-24 Notre Dame roster features quite a few family connections to the program and hockey world. Three sets of brothers are currently on the roster, including Justin and Trevor Janicke, Landon and Carter Slaggert, and Henry and Danny Nelson.
- With the addition of the Nelsons this season, the Irish have had 17 sets of brothers lace up their skates together for the Irish.
- Carter Slaggert also joins the Irish in 2023-24, becoming the third Slaggert brother to appear in a game for the Irish and joins his older brother Landon, who is a senior. Oldest brother Graham currently plays in the Buffalo Sabres organization and skated two years alongside Landon before graduating.
- Senior forward Brady Bjork is the younger brother of former Irish All-American and current Chicago Blackhawk Anders Bjork. Brady's father, Kirt, played for the Irish from 1979-83 where he appeared in 141 and tallied 161 career points (76-85). When older brother Anders played for the Irish, they became the fourth set of father-son combinations within Notre Dame hockey. Both Kirt and Anders were named All-American during their time at Notre Dame.
- The Slaggerts are part of the fifth set of father-son combinations to suit up for the Irish, joining their father and associate head coach Andy Slaggert.
- Justin and Trevor Janicke are the sons of Curtis Janicke, who played for the Irish from 1989-93, appearing in 125 games while scoring 46 goals and adding 98 assists for 144 points. Justin, Trevor and Curtis represent the sixth father-son duo to play for the Irish.
- Freshman Paul Fischer is the nephew of Mike Gearan, a member of the first varsity hockey team at Notre Dame. Fischer will honor his uncle by wearing his number during his career with the Irish, No. 16.
- Freshman forward Cole Knuble is the son of former NHLer Mike Knuble, who spent 16 seasons in the NHL, including stints with Detroit, New York Rangers, Boston, Philadelphia and Washington. Cole was recently drafted by the Flyers' organization where his father played during his early childhood. He will wear No. 22 with the Irish to honor his father.

- The 2023–24 season marks University of Notre Dame hockey coach Jeff Jackson’s 19th season behind the Irish bench. During his first 18 seasons, the program has enjoyed a great deal of success, including four trips to the Frozen Four and eight conference championships.
- Jackson has over 30 years of coaching experience and led Notre Dame to back-to-back Big Ten tournament championship seasons in 2018 and 2019 while also guiding the Irish to the 2018 national title game en route to being named the Spencer Penrose Award winner as the National Coach of the Year.
- Jackson was also named the Spencer Penrose award winner in 2007 and he is one of just 15 coaches to have earned the honor multiple times (dating back to 1951).
- Additionally, Jackson is one of only two coaches to have earned the honor multiple times in the last 17 seasons.
- Jackson’s Notre Dame teams have made 12 trips to the NCAA Tournament, advancing to the Frozen Four four times and playing in the 2008 and 2018 national title games.
- During his 18-year run, Notre Dame has become one of the nation’s top teams while playing in the Central Collegiate Hockey Association, Hockey East and now Big Ten.
- Under Jackson, the Irish won the CCHA regular-season title twice (2006–07 and 2008–09) while earning three Mason Cup championships (2007, 2009 and the final one in 2013).
- Then, in the team’s first season in the Big Ten (2017–18), Notre Dame captured both the regular season and conference championships and followed up by once again winning the conference tournament in year two (2018–19).
- Jackson’s success on the ice also has had a major impact off the ice for the Irish. With the wins came a commitment from the University that led to the new home of Irish hockey — The Compton Family Ice Arena — one of the finest college hockey facilities in the nation. The venue opened for business on Oct. 21, 2011.
- Since Jackson’s arrival, the Irish have had 47 players selected in the National Hockey League Entry Draft, including three first round selections.
- In that same span, 39 players from USA Hockey’s National Team Developmental Program have matriculated to Notre Dame.
